I have a couple of items I would like to mention this evening.

First, I would like to thank the owner of OTT's, Don Bigley, for their \$1000 donation for our Delran 2007 Graduation Class. The money has been received and shall be distributed to the High School and the Middle school in the form of Scholarships.

Four \$200 checks will be awarded to four high school students that have the highest honors in four areas of academic's. The scholarships will be awarded for Math, Science, Business and Language Arts.

Four \$50 bonds will be distributed to four middle school students that have the highest honors in four areas of academic's. The scholarships will be awarded for Math, Science, Language arts and Social Studies. The selection of award winners will be done by the school's principals.
